MORE INTERNET TRICKS EVERYONE SHOULD KNOW:

- 1) Pop Up Nightmares; ever hit one of those sites that start a cascade of pop-up windows so you've ended up rebooting your computer? We all have. One way to close the windows is to look at the task bar, right click on the newest window and chose CLOSE. Sometimes things happen so fast you can't even do that. Instead, press ALT-F4 and that kills the front window. You can tap the keys as fast as the windows pop up, and the worst that happens is you shut down one too many windows (sometimes I have multiple copies of Explorer or Netscape open and only one has hit the pop-up site). Still better than rebooting!
- 2) You don't need to type in 'www.nameofsite.com' into your URL. Type just fsjames into the URL and press CTRL-ENTER. The www and .com are added automatically!
- 3) Move Back and Forth: you can leap ahead or back several pages at a time. Right-click either button, and a pop-up menu displays the last ten sites you've visited. Use keys: hold down the Alt key, then hit the left arrow to move back and the right arrow to move forward.
- 4) Launch a program. Any icon on your desktop will launch if you type it into the URL. I just type FTP into my URL to launch WSFTP, or MailWasher, or AdAware!
