PayPal online payments: We have now set up an online system to renew your account with PayPal. PayPal is one of the largest and most secure online payment systems there is. You simply obtain an account using your Visa, MasterCard, American Express, or bank and make payments via PayPal. It will allow you to shop at thousands of other websites (including e-bay) as well. Renewing online will offer you even more savings on your account [ie 3 mos unlimited is \$79 including taxes, save \$3.44]. It is safe to send your credit information to PayPal online, BUT, watch out for a fake e-mail that says it is them and asks you to reply with your bank info. It is from a virus and does not send them your info. Click the pay online logo at www.fsjames.com or www.maxit.net/2pay_online.htm

Fake e-mail still coming: there is no *administration@cnetdirect.com*, *support@qlynx.com*, or *staff@fsjames.com*. These are virus-infected mails sent by someone's infected computer. The virus [netsky] takes a name from the infected computers address book and e-mails it a copy saying it is from staff, support, or administration @whatever_your_internet_is.com. If it says **Re: your something** do not open it! We wish to remind all our customers that Max will note e-mail you an attachment.

Theatre is online: You can always find out what's on at the Lido by going to www.fsjames.com. The very first banner ad is 'now playing' . If you click the banner, or the other logo for the theatre, or look in the menu [**MENU: In the Fort – Lido Theatre**], you can download a printable schedule. If you miss the banner, just wait and it will come up again in a minute.... You can also find more stuff on our site like restaurant takeout menus [**MENU: In the Fort – Dining**], and a free Buy & Sell [**MENU: Tools - BuyNSell**]

Mailwasher Filtering: You can cut down your junk mail and avoid other mail problems by using MailWasher first. This program is a must have for dialup internet users, as it downloads just the mail headers really fast and lets you delete mail you don't want to tie up Outlook with [*like the 16 Meg file of your nieces birthday party*]. Even though the BOUNCE feature isn't very useful anymore [*almost all the junkmail has a fake address for the sender*] it is able to immediately look for mail from certain domains, or containing certain words and mark it for deletion. When you hit PROCESS MAIL it tosses all these away and calls your normal mail program to get the rest. I use MailWasher with about 100 filter elements and SpamBayes for Outlook [not express version]. One day they tossed out all but one of 177 e-mails. TO bad it was a junk mail too! At www.fsjames.com, there's a complete set of downloadable instructions for [how to set up MailWasher filters](#).
