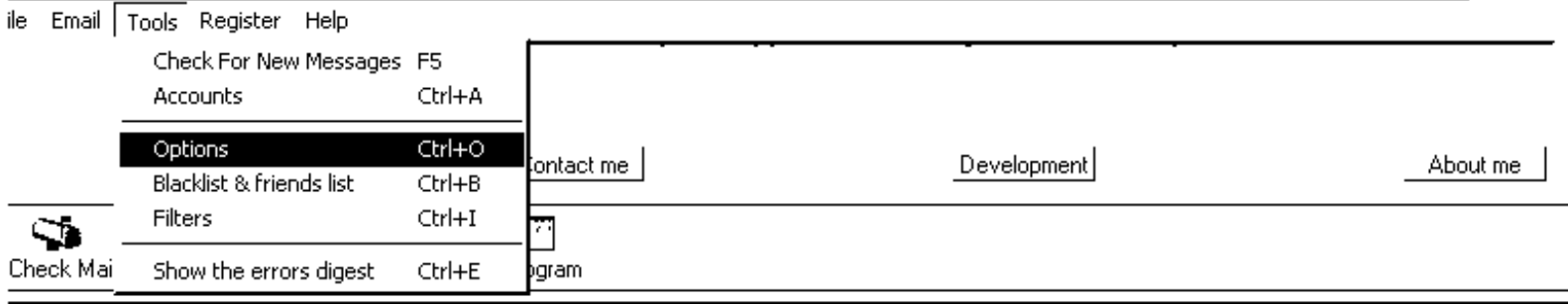


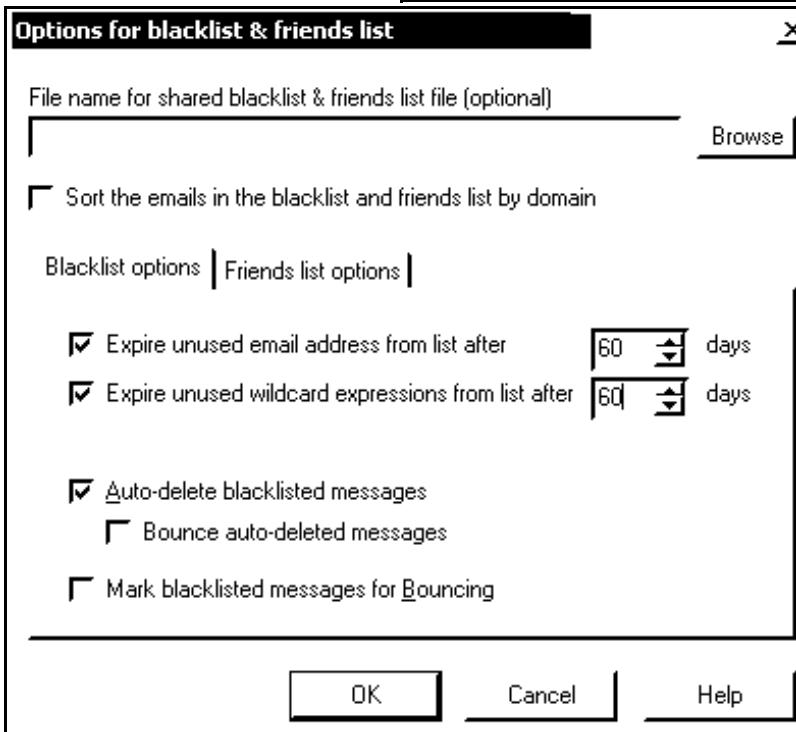
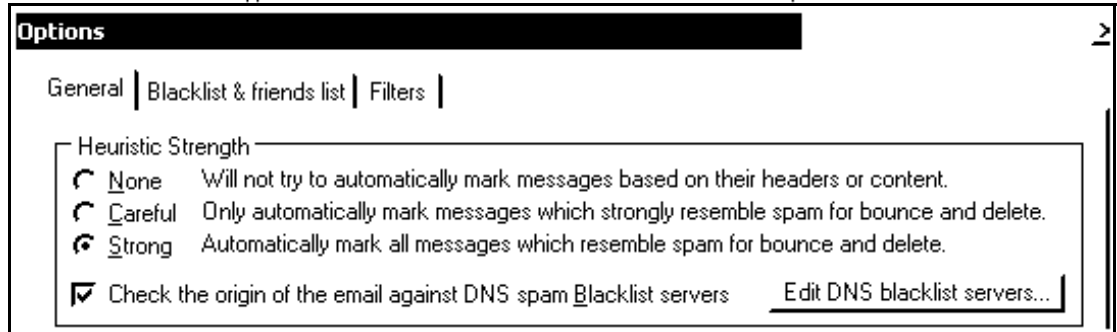
USE MAILWASHER TO 'PRE-FILTER' YOUR MAIL:

after you 'Process Mail' it will call up Outlook to accept the messages that made it past the filters.

MailWasher version 2.0



Under the Tools menu pick Options. At the General page you can raise the default strength to Strong. Check the origins against known spammers via the Internet's Blacklist services.



To prevent your blacklist from getting huge, as spammers usually change addresses and domains regularly, set it to expire after 30, 60 or 90 days.

Check to auto-delete blacklisted messages.

NOTE:

It is now not worth 'bouncing' as almost every spammer uses fake addresses. Bouncing will slow the program down when it errors out trying to send back to phony addresses.

NEXT: Set up some FILTERS by clicking the Filters tab under the Options screen. Highlight the Example Filter, this is a good one. Click the Modify button and you can remove the check mark from bounce if you

wish. Note how this one is set to "all rules must be satisfied". This means that the "To" field in the e-mail address must have both of the words "undisclosed" and "recipient" in order to be filtered out. This is called a Boolean AND process. If you click the More Rules button and add things, ALL the situations must be true for the filter to work. Next set your own filters with the ADD button. The following examples use Boolean OR, if any situation is true, filter the mail. Check the "any rule below is satisfied" box. You may wish to set yours differently, the examples are for guidance only. Check the More Rules to add more examples (max is 10) and the pointer arrow to change what field to look in. Notice how Viagra is filtered in the SUBJECT field, but not the BODY field. This means a joke about viagra would not be filtered, but if the spammer tries to use vi@gra to bypass a filter, it will catch it in either the subject or the body of the message. [Of course then if someone sends a joke about spammers spelling it Vi@gra, it would get filtered out!]. You can remove filters you don't want with the Fewer Rules button.

This example filters out mail coming from specific domains.

It is also set to add any mail from these domains to the blacklist.

With the More Rules button you can set up to 10 rules for each filter.

This is an example of a "Countries" filter. It looks at the domain extension [DOT COM or DOT ORG or DOT COUNTRY]

This marks all mail from Russia, Hungary, Netherlands, Denmark, China to be deleted. It will not stop a dot com in China from sending mail though.

You could also include
 .biz to delete businesses
 .org for organizations
 .gov for government
 .tv is used by some sneaky businesses

This what I call my "enlarge filter" that catches what has to be the stupidest e-mails ever. The spammers don't even check to see what sex you are before sending the junk out. Notice how I left out "breasts" because you never see the word "reduced" in the same message!

Some of us are single and need Viagra like we need to burn ourselves with hot irons!

And here's a filter to catch those spams about medicines. Once again it makes you hate spammers so lazy they don't even check that your Canadian and can buy generic drugs everywhere.

Some aren't even prescription drugs here, you can get them at the 7-11.

And here's a catch-all filter that looks for septic tank stuff
 ink refills
 descramblers
 etc.

Once the mail downloads and all the filters run, you can check process the mail and toss away an awful lot of stuff. Some junk mail will still get through no matter how hard you try.
